Speakers come in with folders for children which may be sponsored. Many parishioners support this activity. Recently, CFCA has changed their name to "Unbound". Their explanation is "CFCA is where we come from, and Unbound is where we are going." Why would they want to hide their identity as Christians? There was discussion in the committee, and while there was not complete agreement, the majority felt that this name change was un-evangelistic, and reduced the opportunity for witness to our Christian faith.
