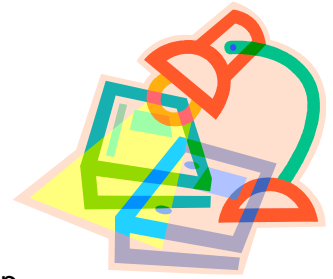


## Christian Classics Book Club
